Fun Facts

- The Disney family's coat of arms appears on one of the arches on the left-hand side of Le Chateau de la Belle au Bois Dormant. The name "Disney" comes from a French village in Normandy called Isigny-sur-mer.
- There are approximately 2 kilometers (1.2 miles) of hedges in Alice's Curious Labyrinth. The hedges were planted three years before the opening of the Resort.
- In celebration of European diversity, the song "it's a small world" is sung in nine different languages, including Dutch, English, French, German, Italian, Spanish, Danish, Arabic and Hebrew.
- More than 600,000 m² of original woodland has been preserved on site. Horticulture and landscape specialists take care of the Resort's more than 18,000 trees, 310,000 shrubs, 964 000 m² of lawns and 8,533 m² of flowers.
- In July 2008, Disneyland Resort Paris began using buses with a fuel additive that helps cut down on greenhouse gas emissions
- Disneyland Resort Paris is committed to buying 15% of its electricity from renewable energy sources, such as solar, wind and hydropower, through the « kWh Equilibre » contract with Electricité de France.
- Disneyland Resort Paris is recognized as one of the first in France to offer employees a company sponsored carpooling program - providing this environmentally responsible service to Cast Members since 1997.
- The Studio Tram Tour: Behind the Magic, which takes Guests on a thrilling tour of The Walt Disney Studios, runs on GNV, a less polluting fuel.
- The Twilight Zone Tower of Terror features three of the largest motors ever build for such a conveyance. They are three times larger than the largest high-speed elevator motors and faster than the fastest high-speed elevator in the world.
- Reaching 183 feet, the Tower of Terror is the tallest attraction at Disneyland Resort Paris.

- With over 30 million meals served each year (up to 150 000 per day), Disneyland Resort Paris is "the largest restaurant" in France. As an example, 4 400 tons of fruit and vegetables are consumed each year on site.
- Disneyland Resort Paris received each year 75 000 direct jobs applications.
- 800 Disney VoluntEARS at Disneyland Resort Paris donate their time and talent to brightening the lives of people in the surrounding community.
- On a sunny April morning in 2007, hundreds of Cast Members assembled on Main Street (Disneyland Park) for the Pioneers photo with Goofy. The photo honors the one in five Cast Members who have been with Disneyland Resort Paris since day one.
